The nine weeks will be divided into subject areas; vocabulary & conversation, writing & grammar, and reading strategies with an emphasis on practical and daily conversations. The English classes for Adult Students will allow participants to talk freely with native English-speakers about a variety of subjects. Adult Students' outcomes will vary based on the level of proficiency coming into the program but will also assure the participants an improved ability to speak, read and write by the end of the program. No matter what level of English you currently speak this course will get you started on a path for continued success.
